Acts 12:8 And the angel said unto him, Gird thyself, and bind on thy sandals. And so he did. And he saith unto him, Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me.

John 9:4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.

Romans 12:11 Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord;

Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do *it* heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, **23** Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

Galatians 4:4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,

Ecclesiastes 3:1 To every *thing there is* a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:

Ecclesiastes 3:13 And also that every man should eat and drink, and enjoy the good of all his labour, it *is* the gift of God.
